Menstrual health is fundamental to the dignity and wellbeing of women and girls, and an important part of basic hygiene, sanitation, and reproductive health services. It is also a determining factor in whether girls attend school beyond adolescence. At schools in the Teso subregion of Uganda, local communities created separate safe spaces for girls to manage menstruation. As a result, the headteacher of one school told us, "Girls are able to continue attending classes even when in their periods, because water is within the school, the safe space has soap, a new pad and even panadol tablets to give to the girls."

As a Water Programs Senior Manager at charity: water, I am honored to oversee our partnerships, implementation strategies, and commitments in Uganda. I am equally honored to have a front-row seat to the life-changing impact of generosity like yours. Your kindness is rewriting stories for girls in the Teso subregion of Uganda, and I can't say thank you enough.
